

Dates: 28/05/2024 & 29/05/2024



An Eye check up camp was organized in D.A.P.M.R.V. Dental College and Hospital, Bengaluru on 28th and 29th May 2024. The camp was conducted by Shekar Eye Hospital, J.P. Nagar, Bengaluru, w.r.t to an email received from RSST.



SANRAKSHANA CAMP REPORT- 10/03/2024






Such camps help in understanding the oral health awareness and conditions in a particular locality/ environment. It was overall a nice learning experience to all of us.




