Yes, the Institution assesses the learning levels of the students, after admission and organises special Programmes for advanced learners and slow performers.

- The students (both undergraduates and postgraduates) are given orientation of each department every year after their admission to the institution. Students are continuously assessed throughout their course and this continuous assessment is documented.
- Based on the performance of the students in the internal assessment examination, their response in practical and tutorial classes and also considering feedback given by the teaching faculty, the students are identified as slow learners and advanced learners.

The Institution:

- 1. Follows measurable criteria to identify slow performers
 - Academic performance in internal assessment is taken into consideration as measurable criteria to identify slow performers and a student with score less than 50th percentile is considered as a slow performer.
 - Completion of the pre clinical or clinical quota of work (within the specified time period) which has been specified by the University is also considered for the identification of slow learners.
- 2. Follows measurable criteria to identify advanced learners
 - Academic performance in internal assessment is taken into consideration as measurable criteria to identify advance learners also and a student with score above 70th percentile is identified as an advance learner.
 - Completion of the pre clinical or clinical quota of work which has been specified by the University much before time than the other average student.
 - Postgraduates are assessed by all the staff members of the respective departments through evaluation forms. Each and every academic activity such as seminar presentations, clinical case presentations, journal club and so on. In addition, regular assessments are carried out in the form of monthly tests and annual examinations. Postgraduates also maintain daily and university log books which reflect their day-today activities.

- Parent teacher meetings are conducted annually for undergraduates, during which parents are given inputs about the performance of their ward and are also given suggestions to help in improving their children further.

- Mentoring and counseling sessions are held by the respective mentors or guides to help the slow performers to improve both academically and also improve their general health and well being.

4. Follows protocol to measure student achievement

- Measures are taken to further improve the knowledge and skills of advanced learners with special assignments and they are encouraged to take part actively in quizzes, competitions and seminars.
- Students selected at institutional level are encouraged to participate in State and National level conferences and competitions. They are also motivated and guided to conduct short term projects to develop research temperament.
- Postgraduates are deputed to higher centers of learning such as NIMHANS, IISc, KIDWAI institute of oncology, St John's hospital for a better exposure to various aspects of the specialty.
