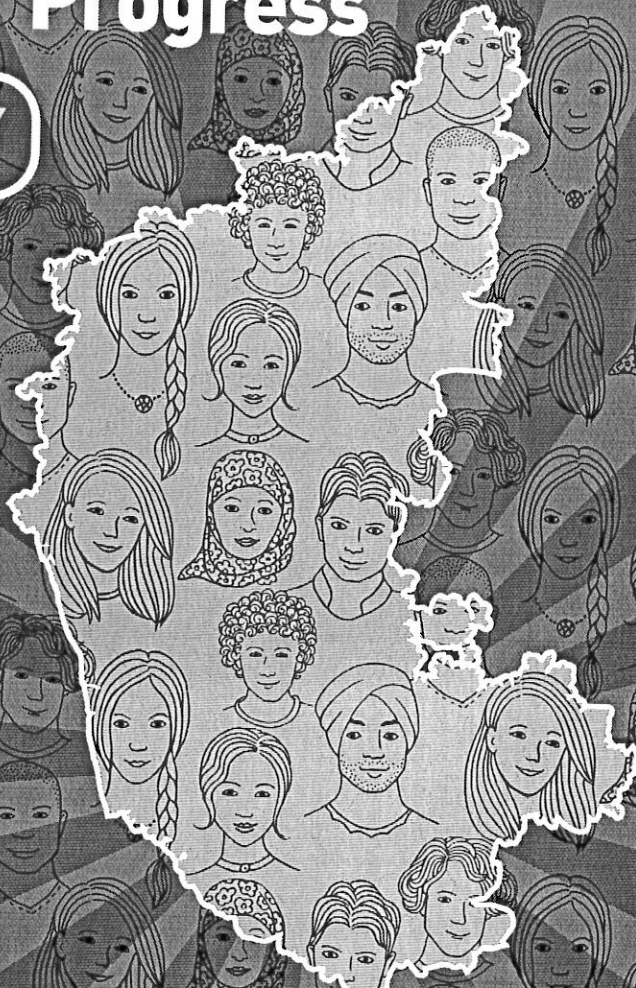

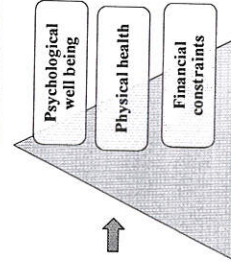
1. INTRODUCTION
