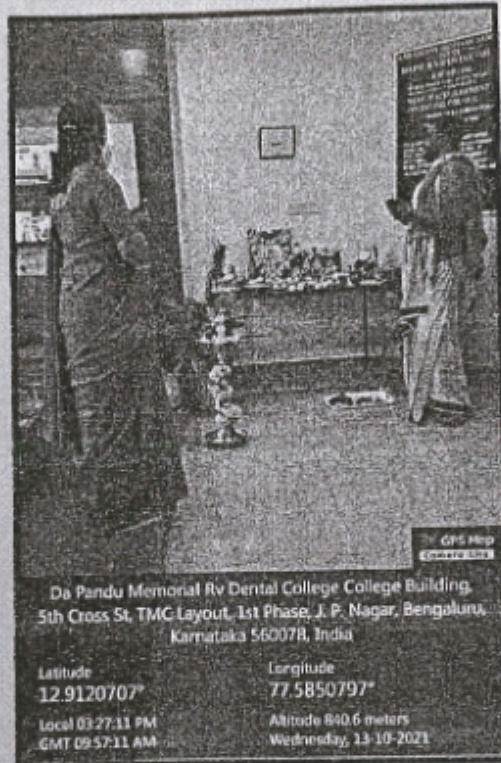

**REPORT ON DUSSHERA POOJA**

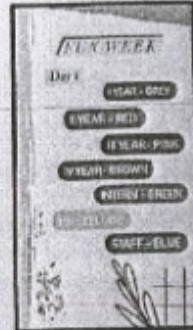
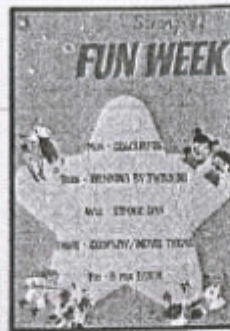

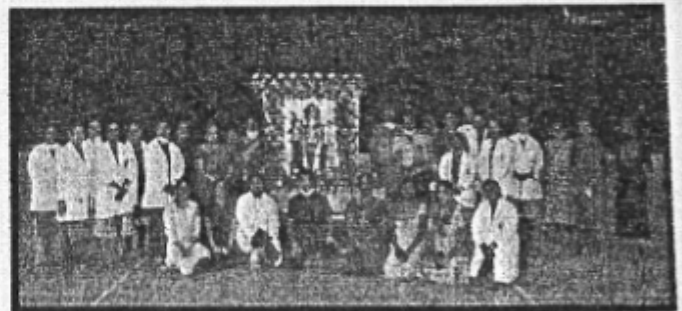

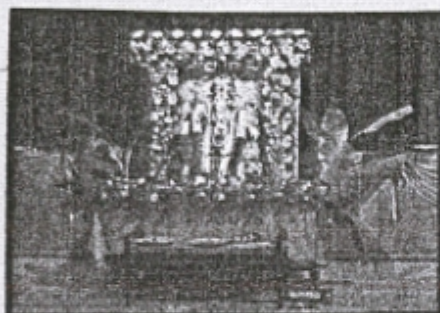

A total of 50 Undergraduate, 25 postgraduate, and 01 certificate course students were awarded graduation certificates.

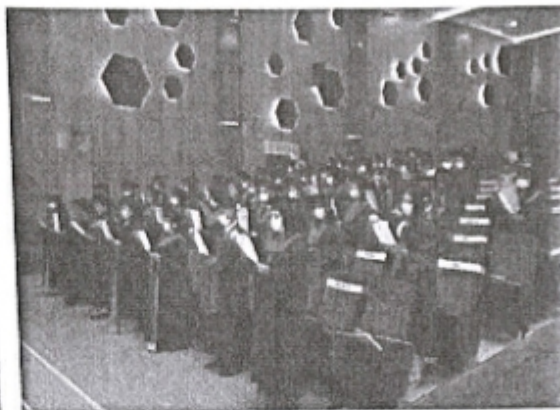

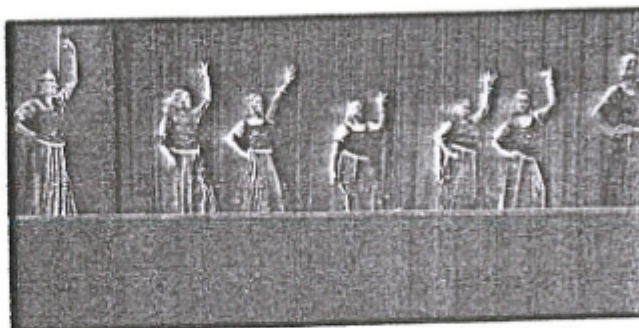
## CULTURAL PROGRAM

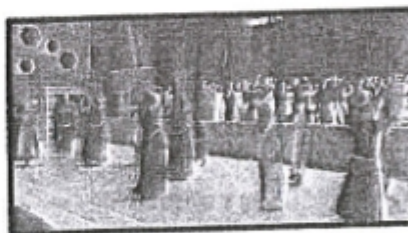

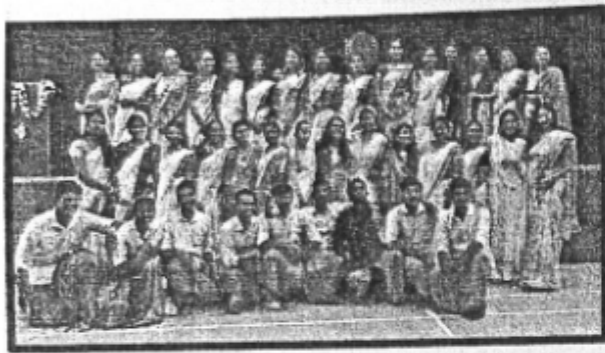

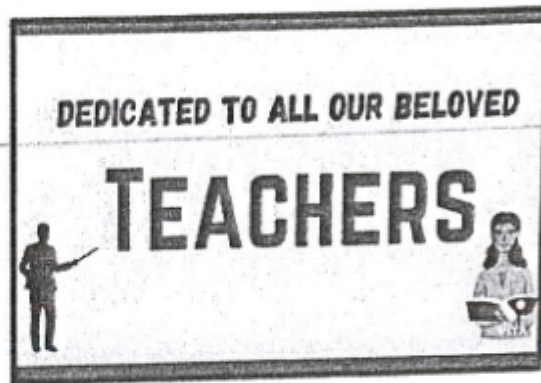
