- The Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka, Bangalore has conducted a short term course in Educational Methodology on 24.02.2015. CAMP & HOSPITAL DETAILS:

- The Department of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry under the guidance of Dr. Anantharaj, Prof & HOD, conducted a School Dental Health Camps at various places in and around Bangalore, Kanakapura and at Hosur, Tuticorin and Tirunelveli Districts of Tamil Nadu during the period from 1st September 2014 to 16th March 2015. A total of 14,011 children from 32 schools and 2 special schools - mentally challenged, visually impaired and deaf and dumb school children. They have been treated with restorative procedures, scaling and preventive restorations and health education.
- The Department of Public Health Dentistry under the guidance of Dr. A.G. Harikiran, Prof & HOD, has conducted 15 camps and treated 1661 patients in camps during the period from September 2014 to March 2015.

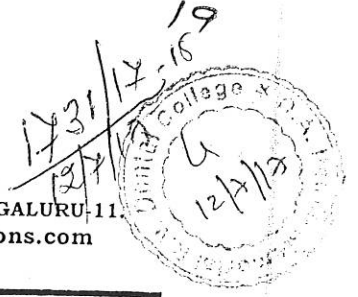





OTHER SUBJECTS

I) The principal informed that the College has recently purchased New imaging machine CBCT(Cone Beam Computed Tomography) and the uses is as follows.

- 1.Provides three dimensional imaging data of a patient at a very minimal x-ray dose.
- 2.High resolution 3D data of small structures.
- 3.Indicated in pre-surgical and post-surgical management of cases.
- 4.Very useful in treating difficult root canal procedures.
- 5.Very useful in planning orthodontic and Dental-facial orthopedic treatments.
- 6.Digital diognisis, treatment planning and follow up of patient.
- 7.Useful in preparing Digital guides and surgical stents.
- 8.Capcity to image the ears and the sleep airways.

II) The Principal informed that OPD collections are good. Since the material charges have gone up the College will propose increase in charges Department wise to the Trust for approval.

III) Regarding the Evening Clinics, the Principal informed that the College will work out the modalities and inform Trust for further needful.
