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STRUCTURE OF TONGUE

- There are numerous important structures surrounding the tongue. It is limited anteriorly and laterally by the upper and lower rows of teeth.
- Superiorly it is bordered by the hard (anterior part) and soft (posterior part) palates.
- Inferiorly, the root of the tongue is continuous with the mucosa of the floor of the oral cavity with the sublingual salivary glands and vascular bundles being located below the mucosa of the floor of the oral cavity.
- The palatoglossal and palatopharyngeal arches have

The presulcal and postsulcal parts of the tongue differ not only by anatomical location, but also based on embryological origin, innervation and the type of mucosa found on its surface.

Anterior two thirds

The presulcal tongue includes the apex and body of the organ. It terminates at the sulcus terminalis; which can be seen extending laterally in an oblique direction from the foramen caecum towards the palatoglossal arch.

The mucosa of the dorsal surface of the oral tongue is made up of circumvallate, filiform and fungiform papillae. There is also a longitudinal midline groove running in an anteroposterior direction from the tip of the tongue to the foramen caecum.

This marks the embryological point of fusion of the lateral lingual swellings that formed the oral tongue.

It also represents the location of the median lingual fibrous septum of the tongue that inserts in the body of the hyoid bone.

- On the lateral surface of the oral tongue are foliate papillae arranged as a series of vertical folds.
- The ventral mucosa of the tongue is smooth and continuous with the mucosa of the floor of the



Classification: Turner and Missirlian classif

Category 1: Excessive wear with loss of vertical dimension of occlusion (VDO)

The patient closest speaking space is more than 1mm and the interocclusal space is more than 4mm and has some loss of facial contour and drooping of the corners of the mouth. All teeth of one arch must be prepared in a single sitting once the final decision is made. This makes the increase in VDO less abrupt and allows a better control of esthetics.

Category 2: Excessive wear without loss of VDO but with space available.

Patients typically have a long history of gradual wear caused by bruxism, oral habits or environmental factors but the occlusal vertical dimension is maintained by continuous eruption. It might be difficult to achieve retention and resistance form because of shorter crown length and gingivoplasty may be needed.

Category 3: Excessive wear without loss of VDO but with limited space.

There is excessive wear of anterior teeth over a long period and there is minimal wear of the posterior teeth. Centric relation and centric occlusion are coincidental with a closest speaking space of 1mm and an

isting clinical situation, the clinician must decide upon the occlusal approach and choose an appropriate occlusal scheme.

Occlusal Approach: for restorative therapy can be either conformational approach or a reorganised approach. It includes two situations

- 1) Occlusion is untouched prior to tooth preparation although small changes can be made on restorations such as elimination of the non-working contacts.
- 2) Occlusion is modified by localized occlusal adjustments before tooth preparation that is shortening of an opposing cusp, elimination of non-working side interferences and removal of a deflective contact on tooth to be restored.

Occlusal schemes: The ideal occlusion for eccentric movements can be classified by three schemes according to the tooth contact condition.

- a) Mutually protected articulation
- b) group function
- c) Balanced articulation.





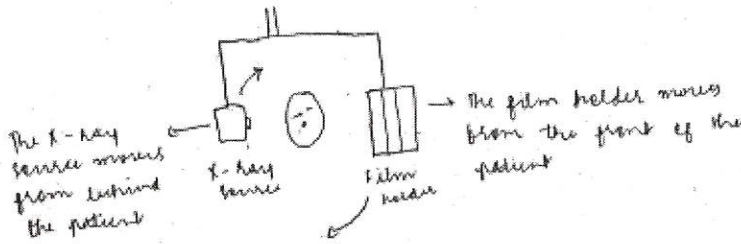

The following are the principles of a panoramic radiograph:

→ The X-ray source & the film holder are mechanically interconnected & the two move in opposite direction.



→ The film inside the film holder rotates along its own axis but in direction opposite to that of the holder.

→ In case of digital sensor the sensor doesn't rotate along its own axis.

→ The X-ray source & film holder complete a rotation of 180°.

## Skin and Its Appendages

1. Name the appendages of the skin

Ans. The appendages of the skin are hair, nails, sebaceous glands and sweat glands. The mammary gland may be regarded as highly specialized appendages of skin.

2 Draw a schematic representation of the hair follicle, sebaceous gland, sweat gland and Nail.



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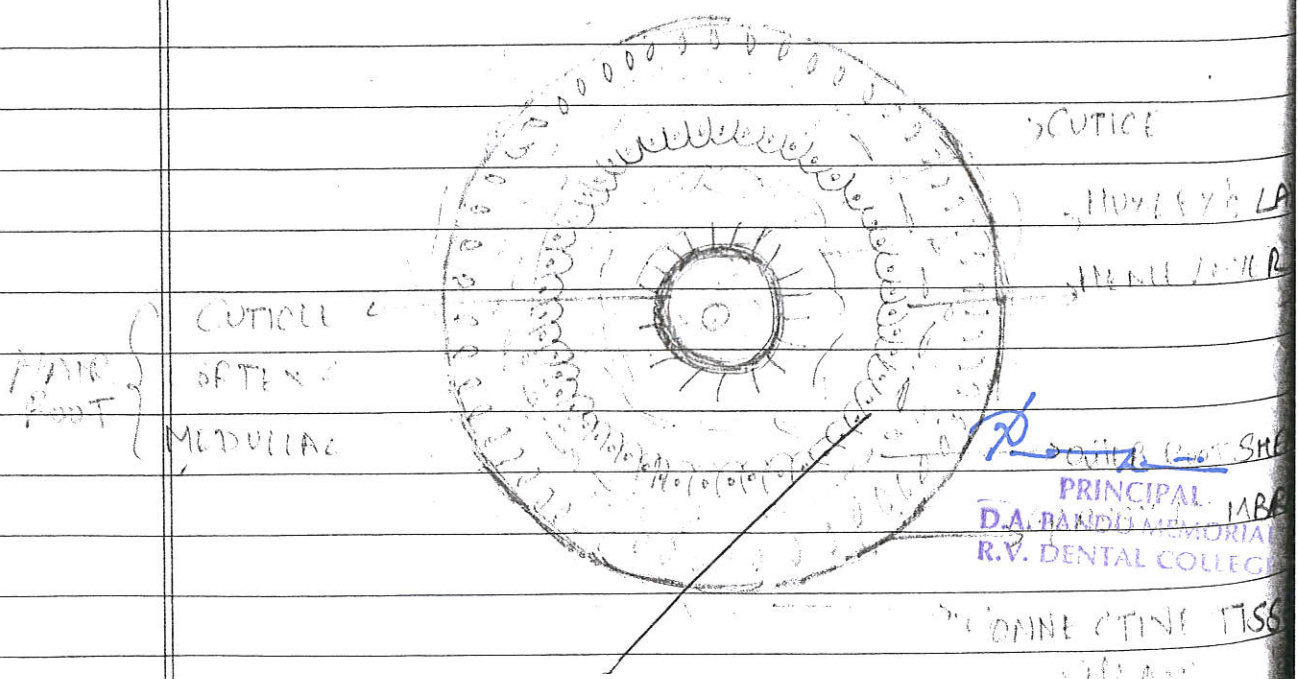
3. Name the sensory receptors in the skin along with specific sensations carried by them. Draw a neat labeled diagram of all the receptors. [LAST PAGE]

Ans. 1. The skin is richly supplied with sensory nerves. Dense networks of nerve fibres are seen in the superficial parts of the dermis.

2. Sensory nerves end in relation to various types of specialized terminals like free nerve endings, Meissner corpuscles, Pacinian corpuscles and Ruffini's corpuscles.

3. Skin also receives autonomic nerves that supply smooth muscle in the walls of blood vessels; the arrector pili muscle and myoepithelial cells present in relation to sweat glands. They also provide a secretory supply to sweat glands. In some regions (nipple, sweat gland) nerve fibres innervate smooth muscle present in the duct.

4. Draw a cross section of a hair follicle and label layers.

5. Define Merocrine, Apocrine and Holocrine glands with examples.

**Merocrine glands:** These glands are those in which cells secrete their substance by exocytosis from secretory cells into an epithelial walled duct or onto a bodily surface or into the lumen.

Eg: Salivary glands

~~**Apocrine glands:** The glands which secrete their secretion in the form of pinched-off buds or vesicles into lumen of gland.~~

~~Eg: Mammary gland~~

**Holocrine gland:** The glands whose secretions are produced in cytoplasm of cells and are released by rupture of the plasma membrane.

Eg: Sebaceous gland.

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6. Name the modification of cells in stratum basale.

Ans. 1. Merkel's cells are sensory receptor cells in stratum basale as mechanoreceptors. They are derived from neural crest cells. Sensory endings are present.

2. Dendritic cells of Langerhans are antigen-presenting cells represent 2-4% of cell population. They protect skin against viral and other infections. They have elongated vacuoles that have been given names Langerhans/Birbeck bodies.

3. Melanocytes - Derived from melanoblasts, produce melanin pigment that imparts colouration to skin.

4. Keratinocytes (intermediate stem cells) - Produce keratin




